THEME=(Lesson-What does author want reader to learn or what did you learn? This is not usually stated directly.)

(Also remember the topic and concluding sentences.)

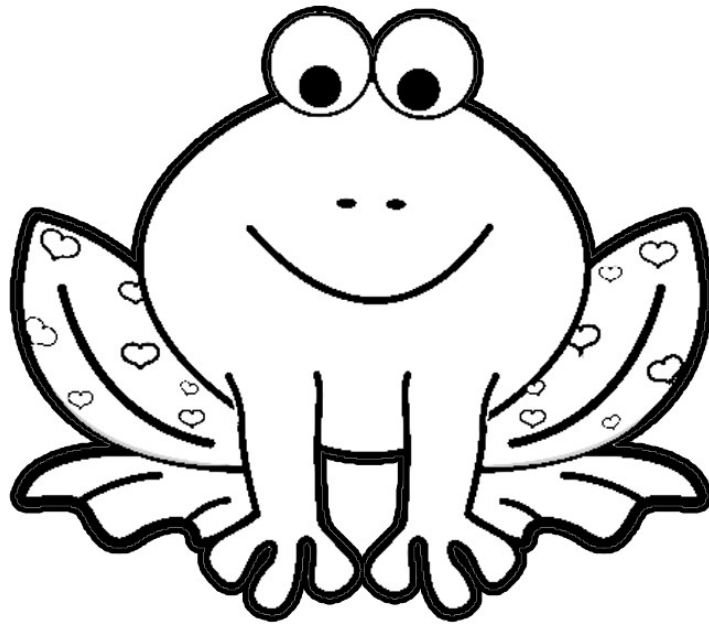
Example:

(Topic sentence) Goldilocks and the Three Bears is a wonderful fictional story! The setting for the main part of the story is in the home of the three bears. The problem is that a little girl named Goldilocks eats the bears' food and sleeps in their beds. The solution takes place when the bears arrive home and eventually frighten the girl away. The lesson in the story is that one should respect other people's property. In conclusion, while this is a children's story, the lesson is one that everyone needs to learn in order to be a responsible adult or young adult.
